



The concept of Circular Economy has become increasingly important in the last decade and this trend is likely to strengthen in the EU in the next years. The European recovery strategy from the Covid-19 emergency is based on the EU Green Deal, which is deeply connected to the New Circular Economy Action Plan adopted by the Commission in March 2020.
