






ENEA Structure



SUN: Symbiosis Users Network (SUN)

“Network Italiano di Simbiosi Industriale - Symbiosis Users Network (SUN)”



Collaboration agreement signed by the stakeholders that join the network:

- Institutions
- Research organizations
- Universities
- Industrial associations
- etc.

ENEA promoter and appointed President

The network is proposed as an Italian reference for **industrial symbiosis operators** at industrial, research and territorial level.

SUN aims to achieve the following objectives:

- **encourage collaboration** and promote contacts and **exchanges of information** and experiences between research institutions, control authorities and companies;
- identify solutions for the main **technical and regulatory criticalities** and for the implementation of industrial symbiosis paths;
- **transfer and disseminate information** via databases, websites, conferences, seminars, etc.

CICERONE H2020 PROJECT - Circular economy platform for European strategic research and innovation agenda

Project financed (*call H2020 CE-SC5-05-2018*): *Coordinated approaches to funding and promotion of research and innovation for the circular economy.*

Objective: elaboration of the **European strategic agenda for research and Innovation funding for circular economy**, allowing efficient use of funding resources avoiding duplication for similar initiatives and overcoming their fragmentation through joint initiatives.

ECESP

Tool to support the transition towards a Circular Economy and the EU CE Action Plan



- A joint initiative of the **European Commission** and the **European Economic and Social Committee**
- An European instrument where stakeholders can meet and exchange across countries and across sectors
- A "network of networks"

ECESP - Members of the Coordination Group

24 representatives of civil society and local governments networks selected from 192 applicants (call for expression of interest was launched in Summer 2017).

ICESP: Italian National Hub for Circular Economy

ENEA was selected by the European Commission as member of the ECESP Coordination Group and as unique Italian representative, it has been asked to act as a National Hub, an interface between Italian Circular Economy Stakeholders and the European Platform.



Main objective: to promote the sharing of best practices
for circular economy implementation on the Italian territory.




