In June 2019, the European Commission has released the update of the Non-Binding Guidelines for Non-Financial Reporting (NBG).

Taking into account the Recommendations of the Task Force on Climate-Related Financial Disclosure, and the Technical Expert Group on Sustainable Finance (TEG) Report, the document provides insights on how companies and financial institutions should approach the climate-related financial disclosure.
